TENTATIVE ITINERARY

TUESDAY, SEPT. 21, DAY 1: *With our group together we begin our journey towards the sun kissed shores of Cape Cod. Our travels today take us to Auburn, New York. Enjoy dinner off the menu this evening at our hotel. (D)*

WEDNESDAY, SEPT. 22, DAY 2: **WELCOME TO CAPE COD:** *After breakfast we continue our travels with stretch and meal stops planned along the way. This afternoon, we cross over the Sagamore Bridge; gateway to ‘the Cape’! The aroma of the salt sea air and the views of the sparkling ocean will surely captivate us!*

Late this afternoon we check into the Red Jacket Blue Water Resort, located on the shores of Nantucket Sound on its own private, sandy ocean beach. Amenities include: indoor and outdoor pool, hot tub, restaurant and lounge plus much, much more. You can view this resort on line at www.redjacketresort.com (blue water resort). This evening we enjoy our Lobster Bake or Steak at the Resort. (B, D))

THURSDAY, SEPT. 23, DAY 3: **HYANNAS, CAPE COD NATIONAL SEASHORE & PROVINCETOWN:** *After breakfast we’ll meet our guide and depart for a full day tour down the Cape traveling along scenic route 6A , otherwise known as Old King’s Highway. You will see village greens, band stands, windmills, peeks of Cape cod bay and more... Atop at the cape Cod National Seashore Visitors Center for a spectacular view off the cliffs overlooking the Atlantic Ocean. before continuing on to “Lands End” – Provincetown. As you enter Provincetown, you will be surrounded by the ocean, sand dunes and beach cottages that dot the landscape. “P-town” is a destination that combines a love of the sea and the arts. Take the time to walk along the waterfront and the narrow main streets and enjoy your free time exploring the shops, galleries and restaurants that make Provincetown so unique. After enjoying lunch on your own you enjoy a Whale Watch Excursion. A Naturalist on board will explain the different marine life you will be seeing during your cruise. Be sure to bring your camera!*

This evening enjoy dinner at the Resort. (B,D)

FRIDAY, SEPT. 24, DAY 4: *Enjoy breakfast prior to checking out of our hotel and traveling to Hyannis to meet our guide who will take us to Cape Cod’s oldest town – Sandwich where you will view the village green, the Great Salt Marsh, a cranberry bog and Cape Cod Bay. Sandwich became the site of one of America’s largest glass factories, an industry that flourished during the 19th century. We will tour it’s Museum and look at some of its valuable pieces. Next we will travel to Plymouth where a picture stop will be made at the Plymouth Rock, Forefather’s Monument and the Mayflower II. Lunch (on your own) and shopping is planned in this historic town.*

This afternoon we journey to Providence, R.I. with a visit planned at the Flax Pond Farms where you will learn about cranberries, cranberry farming, farm equipment, antique harvesting implements and artifacts.

Once in Providence we check into the Radisson Hotel Providence Harbor for the next two nights. Dinner is included tonight at the hotel. (B,D)

SATURDAY, SEPT.25, DAY 5: *After breakfast at the hotel we drive over to Newport, R.I. for a visit to “America’s First Resort”. With your local guide you will explore the city’s historic significance from colonial beginnings through the rich opulence of the “Gilded Age”. You will experience the Ten-Mile Ocean Drive and Bellevue Avenue mansion area plus much more. Tours of the Breakers (Cornelius Vanderbilt) and the Rosecliff (silver heiress Theresa Fair Oelrichs) Mansions are included today.*

Afterwards you will enjoy lunch at the Atlantic Beach Club with shopping and exploring on your own to follow. Later this afternoon we return to Providence for the remainder of the day/evening. (B,L)

SUNDAY, SEPT. 26, DAY 6: **NIAGARA FALLS:** *After breakfast we depart this part of the world and travel to Niagara Falls. There is something about the falls that appeals to the lover, daredevil and poet in everyone. Over the years Niagara Falls has been many things – a strategic military post, a prosperous trade center, a seedy carnival town – but never has it ceased to be a natural wonder, mesmerizing travelers from around the world. Powerful, Majestic, Spectacular....Once you’ve heard the roar at the river’s edge or gazed in awe from above, you’ll want to make your own list of Niagara Falls superlatives. Late this afternoon we check into the Sheraton on the Falls – a perfect locations!!! Enjoy your included dinner this evening overlooking this masterpiece. (B, D)*

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, DAY 7: **HOME:** *Enjoy breakfast overlooking the falls before departing Niagara Falls. Our drive today takes us through Sarnia and back into Michigan. Periodic stretch and meal stops will be made along the way. (B)*
